TRUST DEED

I, **DR. KUMAR PRAFULL CHANDRA S/O SRI SURYA SHEKHAR SINGH** resident of D4/658, Vijayant Khand, Gomti Nagar, Lucknow-226010, Uttar Pradesh hereinafter called the founder trustee solemnly declare at Lucknow this June 24, 2026 that I am desirous of establishing a public charitable Trust with a motive to serve the society at large by making available higher and further technical education, child welfare for human development in rural areas, health/medical facilities, women right and rehabilitation, old age relief, Social awareness and all the basic needs of a person to lead a normal life at cost affordable to the general public of the society without any motive to make any profit or to have any other form of gain by doing so.

Following will also be the **TRUSTEES** of the Trust -



Therefore, for the purpose of establishing the aforesaid trust I hereby set up a trust with an initial personal contribution of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One thousand only) out of the legitimately earned personal income. This amount of money or any other amount deposited or donated in the Trust shall exclusively be used for the furtherance and promotion of the objective of the Trust.

Now it is hereby declared that the aims and objects and scheme shall be as follows:

The Trust shall be known as "**DIABETES RESEARCH & ADVANCED METABOLIC MEDICINE ACADEMY**" (hereinafter referred to as the "Trust/Foundation") and shall be deemed to have come into existence and commenced its operations from the date of execution of this Trust Deed.


The Trust/Foundation may also use and operate under the abbreviated name "**DREAM Academy**", being the acronym and abbreviated form of "**DIABETES RESEARCH & EXCELLENCE IN ADVANCED**



METABOLIC MEDICINE ACADEMY", for all administrative, academic, banking, communication, promotional, statutory, governmental, legal, and other official purposes, as may be required from time to time.


AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE TRUST

1. The Trust is established for charitable purposes, including the advancement of education, medical relief, relief of the poor, welfare of persons with disabilities, upliftment of economically weaker sections, particularly in rural areas, and the advancement of any other object of general public utility throughout the Republic of India, without carrying on any activity for profit
 - a). To establish, acquire, maintain, manage, support, or provide financial assistance, whether in cash or in kind, to hospitals, dharamshalas, medical, engineering and dental colleges, nursing homes, educational institutions, travelling dispensaries, after-care clinics, maternity homes, child welfare centres, orphanages, widow homes and other similar charitable institutions for the benefit of the public in both urban and rural areas.
 - b). To establish, support, acquire, manage, run and/or provide financial assistance to schools, colleges, libraries, reading rooms, hostels, boarding houses, laboratories and other institutions of a similar nature for the promotion, development and advancement of education and dissemination of knowledge among the public.
 - c). To institute and award scholarships, fellowships, stipends, medals, books, medicines and other forms of assistance and incentives to deserving students and individuals without discrimination on the basis of caste, creed, religion, colour, gender or community.
 - d). To adopt villages, townships, blocks, lands or other areas for the overall development and upliftment of economically weaker sections of society through the promotion of cottage industries, dairies, animal husbandry, fisheries, hatcheries, sericulture and other livelihood-generating activities.
 - e). To establish, maintain, support and provide financial assistance to orphanages and other institutions for the relief, rehabilitation and welfare of needy, poor, destitute persons, orphans and widows.





- f). To provide relief, assistance and support to needy, destitute, physically challenged and economically weaker persons without discrimination of any kind.
- g). To provide relief and assistance during natural or man-made calamities, including famine, earthquake, flood, fire, riots, epidemics and other disasters, and to make donations, grants, subscriptions or contributions for such relief activities.
- h). To render assistance and provide grants to public charitable trusts, institutions, societies, temples and other organizations engaged in charitable activities.
- i). To provide fuel and other necessary materials for the cremation or burial of deceased persons and to construct, maintain, repair and manage cremation grounds, crematoriums, burial grounds and related facilities without discrimination on the basis of caste, creed or religion.
- j). To undertake any other charitable activity for the advancement of general public utility not involving the carrying on of any activity for profit.
- k). To maintain proper books of account and records of all receipts, expenditures, assets, liabilities and transactions relating to the Trust and its activities.
- l). To publish academic, educational, technical and healthcare-related materials, including literature relating to integrated management of childhood illnesses, vocational training and public health systems.
- m). To publish newsletters, books, periodicals, journals, research papers, reports, studies and other publications and to coordinate programmes relating to the objects of the Trust.
- n). To facilitate the exchange of experts and technical manpower and strengthen educational, training and development programmes in India and abroad.
- o). To promote the availability of materials, equipment, machinery and supplies required for the programmes of the Trust, including educational and vocational development programmes for children and youth.

- p). To establish, support and promote eye camps, eye banks, eye-care clinics, ophthalmology units and other healthcare facilities independently or in collaboration with Government authorities and other organizations.
- q). To manufacture, procure, purchase, sell and distribute materials, products and articles necessary for achieving the objects of the Trust, provided that any surplus generated shall be utilized solely for the charitable objects of the Trust.
- r). To promote preventive healthcare and undertake programmes for the prevention and eradication of blindness and visual impairment.
- s). To conduct research, establish educational institutions and medical colleges, impart medical and general education, and promote the integration of systems of medicine including Allopathy, Ayurveda, Unani, Yoga and other recognized systems of healthcare on a scientific basis.
- t). To assist in eradicating ignorance, poverty, disease, unemployment and unhygienic conditions and to provide relief in cash or kind during emergencies arising from natural or human-made disasters and catastrophes.
- u). To award scholarships, fellowships, grants and financial assistance to deserving persons for the promotion of the objects of the Trust and cultural, educational and scientific exchanges.
- v). To cooperate and coordinate with international and national organizations, including the United Nations, World Health Organization (WHO), UNICEF, UNESCO, UNDP, Sight Savers, Rotary International, Lions International and other Government, Semi-Government and voluntary organizations pursuing similar objectives.
- w). To raise funds by way of donations, grants, contributions, aid, subsidies and loans from banks, institutions, organizations and individuals for establishing and maintaining educational institutions, hospitals, health centres, medical, dental and engineering colleges and for carrying out the objects of the Trust.




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
- x). To acquire, purchase, lease, mortgage, exchange, hold, develop, manage or otherwise deal with movable and immovable properties, including agricultural and non-agricultural lands, ambulances, medical care vans, mobile clinics and other equipment required for achieving the objects of the Trust, and to arrange financial assistance from lawful sources.
- y). To undertake all lawful activities incidental or conducive to the attainment of the objects of the Trust, including cooperation, coordination, affiliation, amalgamation, bifurcation and management of other charitable institutions having similar objects.
- z). To establish, maintain and operate offices, branches, chapters, centres and units of the Trust anywhere in India or abroad, subject to applicable laws.

MANAGEMENT

1. The Founder Trustee shall be the First President, Managing Trustee and Chairperson of the Trust during his/her lifetime or until resignation, incapacity, or death. The Founder Trustee shall have the authority to appoint, nominate, suspend, remove, or replace Life Trustees, Term Trustees, Patrons, Members of the Board of Governors, Managing Trustees, Chairperson, Co-Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Secretary General, Treasurer, Members of the Executive Board, Governing Council, Managing Committee, International Governing Council, and such other committees or bodies as may be constituted from time to time. The Founder Trustee shall also assign and determine their respective powers, functions, duties and responsibilities.
2. The Founder Trustee may, during his/her lifetime, nominate and appoint any competent person as the Successor Founder Trustee. Upon such appointment becoming effective in accordance with the terms specified by the Founder Trustee, the Successor Founder Trustee shall exercise all powers, authorities and functions vested in the Founder Trustee under this Trust Deed.
3. The overall management and administration of the Trust shall vest in the Founder Trustee. For advisory and consultative purposes, the Founder Trustee may constitute a Board of Trustees comprising:



- i) The Founder Trustee, who shall act as the Managing Trustee and Chairperson of the Board of Trustees; and
 - ii) Such other Trustees as may be nominated by the Founder Trustee.
 - a). The total nominated trustees may be of any number to be determined and nominated by the Founder Trustee in his sole discretion.
 - b). The Founder Trustee may place before the Board of Trustees such matters as he/she considers appropriate for consultation, advice or recommendations
 - c). The term of the Board of Trustees shall be five (5) years from the date of its constitution. Upon expiry of the term, the Board shall stand dissolved unless reconstituted by the Founder Trustee. The Founder Trustee may reconstitute the Board with the same or different Trustees.
 - d). The Founder Trustee shall continue to act as the Managing Trustee and Chairperson of the Board of Trustees during his/her lifetime unless he/she voluntarily resigns from such office.
4. Any vacancy arising due to death, resignation, removal, incapacity or otherwise of any Trustee shall be filled by the Founder Trustee in such manner as he/she may deem fit.
 5. Any Trustee found guilty of misconduct, breach of trust, misappropriation of Trust property, conduct detrimental to the interests of the Trust, or violation of the provisions of this Trust Deed may be removed from office by the Founder Trustee after being given a reasonable opportunity of being heard.
 6. One or more bank accounts shall be opened in the name of the Trust with any scheduled bank or financial institution. Such accounts shall be operated by the Founder Trustee and/or any Trustee or authorized signatory duly authorized by the Founder Trustee by a written resolution or authorization.
 7. The Founder Trustee may assign, delegate or entrust any duty, responsibility or function to any Trustee, officer or committee of the Trust. Such Trustee, officer or committee shall remain accountable to the Founder Trustee for the proper discharge of the assigned duties.

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8. The Trust shall maintain a register containing complete particulars of all movable and immovable properties belonging to the Trust, including details of acquisition, location, valuation and such other particulars as may be necessary for proper administration and record-keeping.
9. The books of account of the Trust shall be maintained on a regular basis and shall be closed at the end of each financial year. A statement of income and expenditure together with a Balance Sheet shall be prepared and placed before the Board of Trustees. The accounts of the Trust shall be audited annually by a Chartered Accountant or a firm of Chartered Accountants appointed for the purpose, and the audited financial statements shall be preserved as part of the records of the Trust.

10. PROCEDURE OF MEETINGS:

- a). The minutes and proceedings of every meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be recorded under the directions of the Founder Trustee and shall be entered in the minutes book maintained for the purpose. The minutes shall be signed by the Chairperson of the meeting and by such Trustees as may be present at the meeting.
- b). Every meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be presided over by the Founder Trustee. In the absence of the Founder Trustee, or if he/she is unwilling to preside, the Trustees present shall elect one amongst themselves to act as the Chairperson of the meeting. The Chairperson shall have a casting vote in the event of an equality of votes.
- c). A minimum notice of three (3) clear days shall ordinarily be given for convening a meeting of the Board of Trustees. However, in cases of urgency, a meeting may be convened at shorter notice, including one (1) days' notice, with the consent of all the Trustees.


11. For the furtherance of the objects of the Trust and subject to the provisions of this Trust Deed, the Income-tax Act, 1961, and other applicable laws, the Founder Trustee and/or the Board of Trustees shall have the following powers:

- a). To accept donations, grants, contributions, subscriptions, gifts, endowments, aid or assistance, whether in cash or in kind, from any individual, institution, trust, society, company, government authority or other lawful source, either as corpus donations or otherwise, with or without conditions.

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
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- b). To apply the whole or any part of the income, corpus, or accumulated funds of the Trust towards one or more of the objects of the Trust in such manner as may be determined from time to time.
- c). To acquire, hold, manage, transfer, exchange, improve, develop, convert or otherwise deal with the properties and investments of the Trust in furtherance of its objects.
- d). To invest and reinvest the funds of the Trust only in the modes and forms specified under Section 11(5) of the Income-tax Act, 1961, and any amendments thereto, and to vary, alter or transfer such investments from time to time as may be deemed expedient.
- e). To borrow, raise or secure monies required for carrying out the objects of the Trust and, where necessary, provide security for such borrowings in accordance with applicable law.
- f). To sell, lease, transfer, exchange, mortgage, surrender, dispose of or otherwise deal with any movable or immovable property belonging to the Trust in furtherance of its objects.
- g). To lease, license or let out any immovable property of the Trust for such period and upon such terms and conditions as may be considered appropriate.
- h). To open, maintain and operate bank accounts in the name of the Trust and to authorize one or more Trustees or other authorized persons to operate such accounts and issue instructions to banks and financial institutions.
- i). To institute, defend, compromise, settle, withdraw, compound or refer to arbitration any suit, claim, demand, dispute or legal proceeding relating to the Trust or its properties.
- j). To appoint attorneys, agents, consultants, advisors, professionals and other representatives and to delegate to them such powers and duties as may be considered necessary for the administration of the Trust.
- k). To appoint administrators, committees, managing trustees, officers, employees or other functionaries and to prescribe their powers, duties, terms of appointment and remuneration, if any.




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- l). To frame, amend, modify, alter or rescind rules, regulations, schemes and policies for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the proper management and administration of its affairs.
- m). To establish, discontinue, merge, reorganize or revive any charitable institution, programs, project or activity undertaken by the Trust in furtherance of its objects.
- n). To earmark, allocate or set apart the whole or any part of the income, corpus or accumulated funds of the Trust for any of its objects.
- o). To cooperate, affiliate, associate, collaborate, merge or amalgamate with other charitable trusts, societies, institutions or organizations having similar or allied objects, subject to applicable law.
- p). To establish, promote, support, participate in or collaborate with institutions, societies, trusts, companies or other entities for achieving the objects of the Trust, provided that such participation is consistent with applicable charitable and tax laws.
- q). To manage the Trust Fund and to collect, receive, realize and recover rents, interest, dividends, grants, donations and other income, and to incur expenditure necessary for the administration and management of the Trust.
- r). To provide financial assistance for medical treatment, surgical treatment, medicines, food, rehabilitation and other related welfare activities for needy persons.
- s). To establish, maintain, support and provide financial assistance to public charitable institutions through grants, donations, gifts or other lawful means.
- t). To establish, maintain, support and assist schools, colleges, educational institutions and training centres, and to award scholarships, stipends and other educational assistance to deserving students.
- u). To undertake and support any other charitable activity for the advancement of education, medical relief, relief of the poor and other objects of general public utility in accordance with law.



- 12.** The Trustees shall have the power to make donations, grants, contributions or provide financial assistance, out of the income or corpus of the Trust Fund, to any charitable trust, society, institution, organization or other entity established in India and having objects similar or allied to those of the Trust, subject to the provisions of the Income-tax Act, 1961 and other applicable laws. The Trustees may also establish, maintain, support or carry out any charitable activity consistent with the objects of the Trust.
- 13.** The Trustees shall be accountable only for such monies, securities, investments and properties as may actually come into their hands or under their control. No Trustee shall be liable for any act, omission, neglect, default or misconduct of any other Trustee, banker, agent, employee or other person with whom any part of the Trust Fund or property may be deposited, invested or entrusted, provided that such Trustee has acted in good faith and with reasonable care.
- 14.** No Trustee shall be entitled to receive any remuneration, salary or other pecuniary benefit from the Trust for acting as a Trustee. However, a Trustee shall be entitled to reimbursement of all reasonable and actual expenses incurred in connection with the administration of the Trust and the discharge of his or her duties.
- 15.** The number of Trustees shall not be less than one (1) and shall not exceed three (3), unless otherwise determined by amendment of this Trust Deed in accordance with law.
- 16.** Any Trustee may resign from office by giving not less than one month's prior written notice to the Founder Trustee or, in the absence of the Founder Trustee, to the Board of Trustees. Such resignation shall take effect upon its acceptance or upon the expiry of the notice period, whichever is earlier.
- 17.** The Founder Trustee may, from time to time, frame rules and regulations governing the conduct of meetings of the Trustees. In the absence of such rules, the following provisions shall apply:

 - a).** The presence of the Founder Trustee shall constitute the quorum for a meeting of the Trustees.




- b). All matters, except those expressly reserved for the Founder Trustee under this Trust Deed, shall be decided by a simple majority of the Trustees present and voting at a duly convened meeting.
- c). A resolution passed by circulation and approved in writing by not less than two-thirds of the Trustees entitled to vote shall be as valid and effective as a resolution passed at a duly convened meeting of the Trustees

18. The Trustees may appoint and remunerate agents, advisors, consultants, professionals, bankers or other persons for carrying out any business, transaction or act relating to the Trust and may delegate such powers and duties as they consider necessary for the efficient administration of the Trust. The Trustees shall not be liable for any loss arising from the acts or omissions of such persons, provided they have acted in good faith and exercised due care in making such appointments.

19. The Founder Trustee may, by a written instrument, delegate any of his or her powers, authorities or functions under this Trust Deed to any nominee or authorized person for such period and upon such terms and conditions as may be specified in the instrument of delegation.

20. The Trustees shall have the power to determine, in cases of doubt, whether any receipt, asset, investment or property shall be treated as capital or income of the Trust and whether any expenditure shall be charged to capital or income. Such determination shall be final and binding, provided that no part of the corpus or income of the Trust shall be applied for any purpose not authorized by this Trust Deed or applicable law.

21. The Trustees shall have the power to settle accounts and to compromise, compound, abandon, defend, institute or refer to arbitration any claim, demand, dispute, suit, action or legal proceeding relating to the Trust or its affairs, upon such terms as they may deem fit and proper.



22. The Trustees shall have the power to borrow or raise money for the furtherance of the objects of the Trust, with or without security, upon such terms and conditions as they may consider appropriate and in accordance with applicable law. The Trustees may create charges, mortgages or other encumbrances over the Trust property for securing such borrowings where necessary.


23. It shall be lawful for the Trustees:

a). To apply to the Central Government, State Governments, local authorities, municipal bodies, statutory authorities, public bodies, corporations, companies, institutions, organizations or individuals for grants, donations, gifts, subscriptions, contributions, aid, assistance or other financial support for the promotion and advancement of the objects of the Trust, and to accept the same upon such lawful terms and conditions as may be imposed.

b). To discuss, negotiate, enter into arrangements and cooperate with Government Departments, public authorities, corporations, companies, institutions, organizations and individuals in relation to schemes, projects, programmes and activities connected with the objects of the Trust.

c). To take over, merge, affiliate, collaborate or amalgamate with any charitable trust, society, association, institution or organization having objects similar or allied to those of the Trust, subject to applicable law.

d). To establish, promote, organize, manage, maintain or assist in the establishment, promotion, organization, management or maintenance of branches, chapters, centres, institutions, societies, trusts or other organizations having objects similar to those of the Trust.

e). To acquire, take over, manage, control, support or provide assistance to any existing institution, organization or establishment having objects wholly or partly similar to the objects of the Trust upon such terms and conditions as may be deemed expedient.


f). To purchase, acquire, undertake, transfer or otherwise deal with the whole or any part of the assets, properties, liabilities, obligations and undertakings of any trust, society, institution, association or organization having similar charitable objects, subject to applicable law.

24. The Trustees shall cause proper books of account and records to be maintained in respect of all receipts, payments, income, expenditure, assets and liabilities of the Trust and all matters relating thereto. The books of account shall be maintained at the Registered Office of the Trust or at such other place as may be determined by the Trustees from time to time.

25. The Trustees shall cause annual financial statements, including the Income and Expenditure Account, Receipts and Payments Account and Balance Sheet, to be prepared in respect of each financial year. The accounts of the Trust shall be audited annually by a Chartered Accountant or a firm of Chartered Accountants appointed by the Trustees, and the audit report shall be placed before the Trustees for consideration and record.

26. The financial year of the Trust shall commence on the 1st day of April each year and shall end on the 31st day of March of the succeeding year.

27. The Trust is and shall remain irrevocable. No part of the Trust Fund or income thereof shall be distributed among the Settlor, Founder Trustee, Trustees or any other specified person, except as permitted by law and for reimbursement of legitimate expenses incurred in furtherance of the objects of the Trust.

29. It is expressly declared that the income and property of the Trust shall be applied solely towards the promotion and attainment of the objects of the Trust. No part of the income or property of the Trust shall be applied or utilized for any purpose other than those specified in this Trust Deed and permitted by applicable law.

30. SUITS AND LEGAL PROCEEDINGS:

a). All suits, actions and legal proceedings by or on behalf of the Trust shall be instituted, prosecuted or defended in the name of the Trust through the Founder Trustee or any Trustee, officer, employee or authorized representative duly authorized by the Founder Trustee or the Board of Trustees. All pleadings, applications, Vakalatnamas, affidavits, compromises and other legal documents shall be signed and executed by such authorized person.


b). All expenses relating to such legal proceedings, including professional fees, court fees and other incidental expenses, shall be incurred and paid out of the funds of the Trust in accordance with the directions of the Founder Trustee or the Board of Trustees

c). No compromise, settlement, withdrawal or adjustment of any suit, claim or legal proceeding pending before any court, tribunal, authority or other forum shall be binding upon the Trust unless approved by the Founder Trustee or the Board of Trustees, as the case may be.

31. PROPERTIES VESTED IN THE TRUST:

All movable and immovable properties vested in or belonging to the Trust, whether presently held or acquired in future, shall be utilized solely for the objects of the Trust. Such properties shall not be sold, transferred, exchanged, mortgaged, pledged, leased, gifted or otherwise alienated except where such action is considered necessary, expedient or beneficial for the attainment of the objects of the Trust and is approved in accordance with the provisions of this Trust Deed and applicable law.

In the event of the death, resignation, incapacity, or inability of the Founder Trustee to act, the remaining Trustee(s) shall assume and exercise the management, administration, possession, custody and control of all institutions, assets, properties, both movable and immovable, funds and affairs of the Trust. Such Trustee(s) shall be vested with and entitled to exercise all powers, authorities, discretions and functions which were vested in or exercisable by the Founder Trustee under this Trust Deed.

Where three Special Trustees have been appointed by the Founder Trustee, they shall jointly administer the affairs of the Trust and shall endeavour to arrive at decisions by mutual consensus. In the event that consensus cannot be reached, decisions shall be taken by a majority vote of the Special Trustees, and such decision shall be final and binding upon the Trust.
